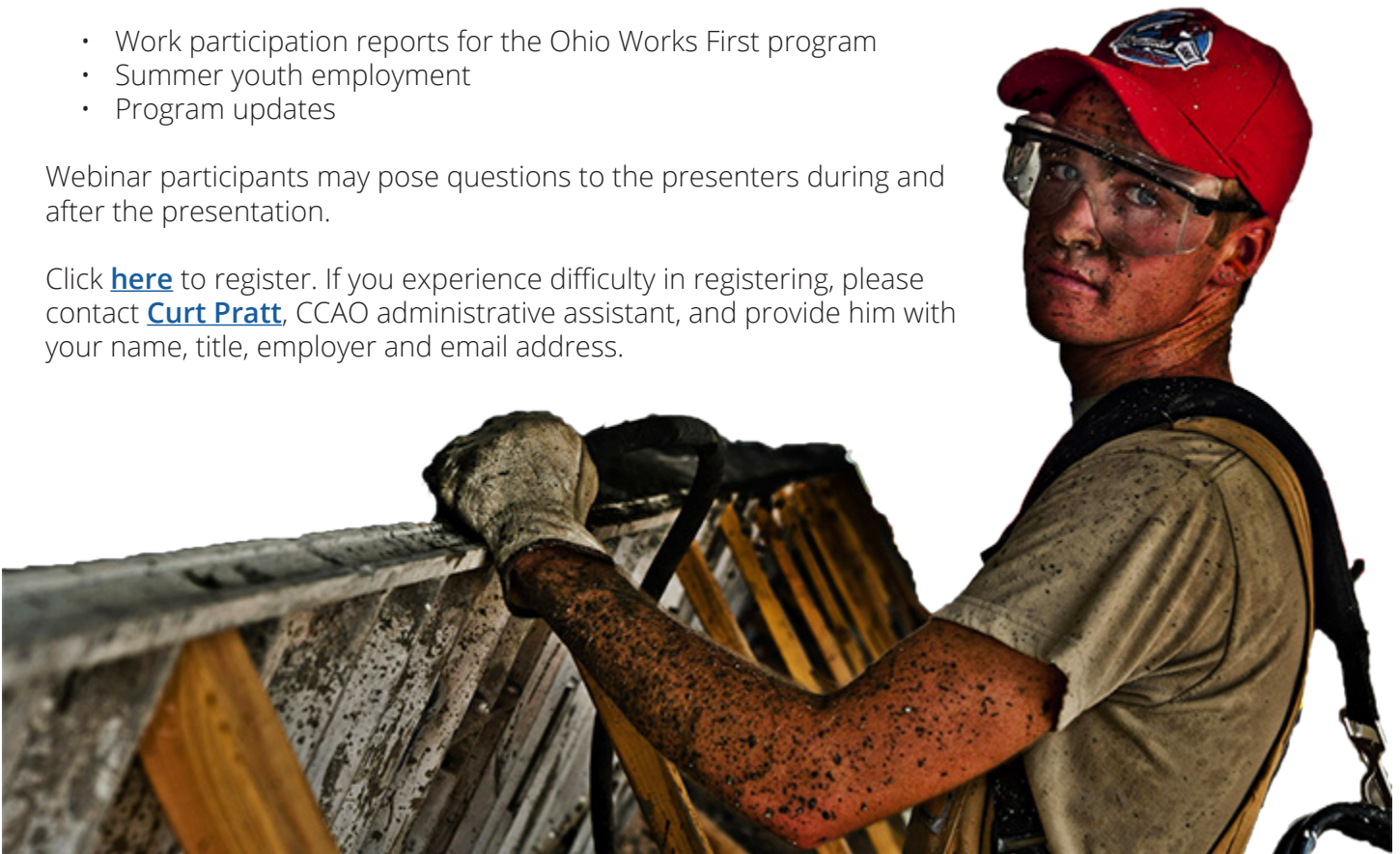

Last summer, Ohio launched the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program (CCMEP) to help Ohioans move beyond welfare into meaningful employment. The program provides comprehensive employment, training and supportive services to at-risk youth ages 16 to 24 by combining Temporary Assistance for Needy Families and Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act youth funds.
