



## **A New Way to Work: An Update on the Comprehensive Case Management & Employment Program**

CCAO is pleased to offer a one-hour “A New Way to Work: An Update on the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program” webinar on September 9 at 9:30 a.m. Ohio’s new state operating budget establishes a statewide framework that is designed to transform the network of human service and workforce programs to find a “New Way to Work” for Ohioans in poverty, focusing on with 16- to 24-year-olds, where early intervention can have the greatest impact. This is to be accomplished by aligning Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) monies, with the goal of ensuring that the strengths of local workforce and human services systems are leveraged in a way that focuses on people, not programs.

Douglas Lumpkin, deputy director of the Office of Human Services Innovation (OHSI), will provide an update on the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program recently signed into law and specifically address:

- Implementation timeline
- County plan requirements
- Designation of a lead agency
- Fiscal update
- Populations served
