



Lake Erie License Plate Proceeds Fund Projects to Benefit the Watershed

The Ohio Lake Erie Commission (OLEC) awarded three grants through Ohio's Lake Erie Protection Fund to Heidelberg University, The Ohio State University and Cleveland State University. The fund was established to help finance research and projects aimed at protecting, preserving and restoring Lake Erie and its watershed.
