



Legislative Update on Congress and county priorities

With the end of the year quickly approaching, there are several serious issues that Congress must address, including how to finalize the fiscal year 2016 appropriations process, how to proceed on a long-term surface transportation bill when the short term extension expires in October and whether or not to raise the federal debt ceiling.
