



## **DOL awards \$2 million to help dislocated Ohio coal workers**

The U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) awarded a \$2 million National Dislocated Worker Grant to the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for reemployment and training services to dislocated workers impacted by coal industry layoffs in Ohio. The grant is part of the [Partnership for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization \(POWER\) Initiative](#) announced in March.

The grant's funds will provide training, work-based learning, and supportive services to dislocated coal miners and other dislocated workers impacted by mass layoffs in the coal industry.
