"Being selected to lead CCAO in 2021 is the highlight of my career as an elected county official. There are many challenges ahead in 2021 but also great opportunities for success," Bubb said. Wachtel in his inauguration speech also conveyed the challenges the upcoming year will bring.

"With so much uncertainty still ahead, setting grand plans and lofty goals for 2021 is difficult at best; however, there are a few things we all can work toward this year," Wachtel said during his inauguration acceptance speech. "We must do all we can to stay safe during this public health emergency. We must keep our employees safe, be more patient, flexible, adaptable, and compassionate and do the right thing for the right reason."
